## ANNUAL SOCIETY STAMP and POSTCARD AUCTION SATURDAY 23<sup>rd</sup> MARCH 2024

Welcome once again to our annual Stamp and Postcard Auction, a regular event in our Society calendar now since 1987.

The material we have to offer remains as varied as ever, and with competitive reserves ensures that in this sale there will be something for everyone. We have several "bulk" Lots, albums and collections containing plenty of worthwhile surprises; and world-wide material from many countries and places we perhaps have not heard of before. For the purist collector there are our usual selection of single items, sets, varieties, errors and postal history, with particular strength in 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century GB.

Postcards have always been a feature at our Sales and in addition to cards with many local scenes, we have a wide selection of worldwide postcards.

For many years we have endeavoured to bring together material that reflects what collectors are looking for, so we anticipate some lively competition throughout the Sale.
